



LOCAL RULES

To be read in conjunction with those printed on the Scorecard.

- Machinery tyre ruts and areas of extreme temporary wetness or mud are GUR. Also includes Core filled areas and washouts in bunkers. Free relief under Rule 16-1b and 16-1e.
- On own mown fairway, if paspalum stalks interfere with the lie of the ball, or the player's area of intended swing, **NOT** solely the player's stance, the ball may be lifted, cleaned and placed within one club length of its original position, not nearer the hole.
- Bark Gardens in the area around the Green Keeper's compound are treated as GUR.
- Sand Shed (9th & 11th holes) Building is an immovable obstruction. Free relief under Rule 16-1a. GUR marked with blue stakes, free relief under Rule 16-1b.
- Ball striking **power lines** or a **pole** supporting power lines **MUST** be replayed without penalty from where the previous stroke was made. (See Rule 14.6 for procedure).
- 14th Hole is a **compulsory** call up hole for black and blue tees only. (See Appendix G 6.7 for procedure).
- All stone walls except those that define O.O.B. or penalty areas are immovable obstructions.
- GUR is defined by any area encircled by a white line or blue stakes.
- Penalty areas are defined by red lines or red stakes.
- Out of Bounds is defined by any fence bounding the course or beyond any line of white stakes.
