COVID-19 Level 2 Golf Guidelines at Sherwood Park Golf Club

The Board advise you all, that following the Prime Minister's announcement yesterday that we return to COVID-19 Level 2 Alert, Sherwood Park Golf Club will remain open to all Members and Visitors.

- **COMPULSORY CHECK-IN** - Members and visitors **must check-in** upon arrival at the club by either using the DotGolf App or writing your details on the check-in sheet located outside the shop or in the clubhouse. There is no requirement to book a tee time – however you are welcome to use the tee booking system to secure a tee time as available.
- **PLAYING CONDITIONS** - Physical distancing of 2 meters between all staff, players and visitors should be maintained on the golf course and throughout all club facilities. Bubbles are not a consideration when choosing your partners. Groups of up to four are allowed.
- **MEMBERS' PLAYING TIMES** - Competitions and tournaments as noted in the Programme Book may be changed, however the regular weekly schedule of golf and club days will continue (as noted in the Programme Book on page 19).
- **GOLF SHOP & HAGGLES** - The Golf Shop will be open for full service. Haggles will be organised as usual.
- **FACILITIES** - Toilets in the club house and on the course will remain open. The Office will follow its usual hours.
- **CATERING** - The Tee Café will remain open for service. Please follow the instructions for service and ensure you follow the social distancing recommendations.
- **BAR** - The Clubhouse Bar will continue to open for regular service on club days and Friday afternoons from 3 pm. Please follow the instructions for service and ensure you follow the social distancing recommendations. Maximum 100 persons in the clubrooms at one time.
- **GOLF CARTS** - Privately owned golf carts may be used but must be thoroughly cleaned and sterilised after each use. Golf carts owned by the Club are available for hire but must be thoroughly cleaned and sterilised after each use – please assist in this regard. Arrange your booking with the shop or online.
- **COURSE SET-UP/LOCAL RULES** – Flagsticks will be placed in the holes on the greens, do not remove or touch them under any circumstances. Inserts will be placed in the holes to allow the ball to come to rest below the surface of the green but reduce the risk of touching the pin or cup when retrieving your ball. Putts less than 30cm in length are to be taken as

gimmies. Rakes will be removed from the bunkers, and all bunkers will be GUR (until further notice).

- **CARDS** - Scorecards will be printed and entered into the DotGolf system. Please mark your own cards. (See local rules for information about Marker's certification of score.) If the shop is closed, pre-printed blank cards will be available outside the shop.
- **ENSURE YOUR SAFETY** – Please be careful and safe. Carry a personal supply of hand sanitizer – and use it often. Enjoy your golf and your friends – but don't shake hands at the end of your round. Do not come to the club if you are unwell. Wash your hands. Wash your hands.
